

## Guide to upload the presentation

**(Computer Science Engineering BSc/MSc, Business Informatics MSc, Computer Science BSc/MSc, Data Science MSc)**

Those students who do not have to defend their thesis (i.e. defended it before successfully or TDK paper or FIRCC paper was accepted as thesis), do not have to create presentation.

Graduating students who are on the program of Business Informatics BSc, do not have to create a presentation.

**Before uploading the presentation students on the programs CSE BSc/MSc, BI MSc, CS BSc/MSc, DS MSc must indicate the name of the board and the date of the final exam.**

**We ask everyone to indicate the date you have been registered (assigned) for the state exam according to Neptun. You can check in the Neptun by 6<sup>th</sup> of May:**

**Presentation upload deadline:**

### **Structure of the presentation (10 slides max):**

1. Thesis title, author and supervisor' s name (1 slide)
2. Problem posing, presenting the background, the task to be solved, including and highlight the independent work (1- 2 slides)
3. Brief, factual summary of the principles, methods and technologies used for the solution (1-2 slides)
4. Description of the independent work (planning, development, measurement, analysis, testing) (1-2 slides)
5. Conclusions, suggestions, description of further development opportunities (1 slide)
6. Acknowledgments, bibliography (1 slide)

**If software/hardware has been created, a screenshot, short video or demo should be shown in the presentation.**
