

# Guide to the presentation uploading

(Computer Science Engineering BSc, Computer Science BSc/MSc)

Those students who don't have to defend their thesis (i.e. defended it before successfully or TDK paper was accepted as thesis), don't have to create presentation.

Students on the program of Business informatics BSc and Computer Science Engineering MSc don't have to create presentation either.

**Students on other programs must give the board and the date of the final exam before uploading the presentation. We ask everyone to enter the day you have been registered (assigned) according to Neptun which will be created by the Education Office by 8<sup>th</sup> of May latest. You can check in the Neptun:**

*Administration/Final exams/"+"/Details*

**You can check the expected starting time and row number 1 day before the Exam date at latest.**

*Administration/Final exams/"+"/Details: Assigned time and date; Number*

## **Presentation upload deadline:**

03rd June 2024.; (Monday) 12.00

### **Structure of the presentation (10 slides max):**

1. Thesis title, author and supervisor name (1 slide)
2. Problem posing, the task to be solved, including the highlighting independent work (1- 2 slides)
3. Brief, factual summary of the principles, methods and technologies used for the solution (slides1-2)
4. Description of independent work (1-2 slides)
5. Conclusions, suggestions, description of further development opportunities (1 slide)
6. Acknowledgments, bibliography (1 slide)

**If software/hardware have been created, a screenshot, short video or demo should be shown in the presentation.**
