


- Download the SAP GUI from this link: https://arato.inf.unideb.hu/racz.anett/SAP/SAP\_GUI.exe

Click next int he appearing screen without any modification.




## Enter the following information on next screen:




After entering the data above click finish. (You can not enter into the system yet!!!)

Source port: 3200


Destination: 193.6.135.142:3200



Click on Add button.
