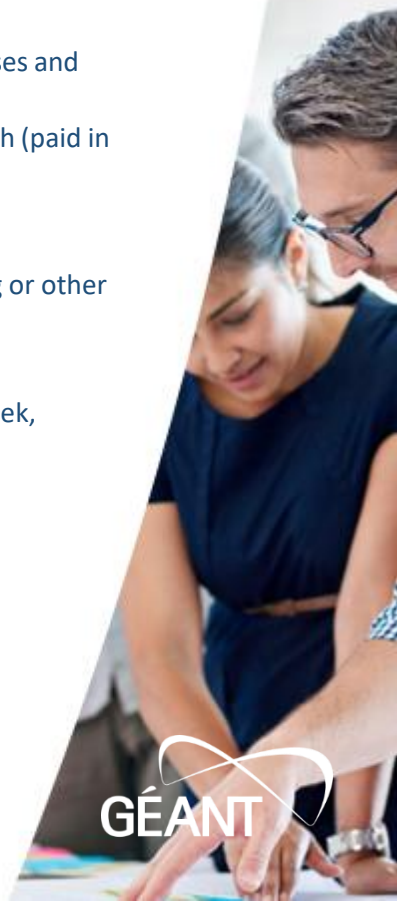
1. Send your CV and accompanying letter to KIFÜ: geant-tim@niif.hu by **01 June 2020 (24:00 CEST)**.
